

Veterans Administration Aid and Attendance Benefit Program

This benefit is available to eligible Veterans or their Surviving Spouses. This program can help offset some of the costs of Medical, Assisted Living, Home HealthCare or Nursing Home Care Expenses.

-----Who is Eligible?

-----Veterans must meet these 3 Criteria!

- 1.) Wartime Veterans who are 65 or older, or permanent disability in need of Assisted Living or HomeCare
- 2.) The veteran must have served at least 90 days of active duty during a war period.
- 3.) The Veteran must have received an Honorable, General or Medical Discharge.

-----Assets and Income must be meet Qualification Limits-----

Viet Nam	02/28/1961---05/07/1975
Gulf War/Iraq	08/20/1990---Present

Veteran with Spouse Benefit	\$2,054.00
Unmarried Veteran	\$1,732.00
Surviving Spouse of Veteran	\$1,113.00

- * Educating the veteran and family on the Veterans Benefit Program
- * Meet with you and Veteran and personally assess the individual benefit qualification
- * Complete and accurately fill-in all Veterans Administration forms for you.
- * Hand-Deliver your completed forms to the County Veterans Administration Representative
Follow-up with application processing until completion and benefits awarded.
